

Ordinance No 1.



The Town of Dundee does ordain as follows
 "Sec 1".

Fines
 for
 disorderly
 Conduct.

That any person or persons who shall be guilty of any violent, riotous or disorderly conduct or who shall use any profane, abusive or obscene language within the town of Dundee or who shall be guilty of any indecent or immoral act, or practice, in said town shall upon conviction thereof in the Recorder's Court pay a fine of not less than five (\$5) dollars, nor more than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars, or be imprisoned in the Town or County jail not less than two (2) days, nor more than sixty (60) days or both at the discretion of the Court.

"Sec 2"

Fine
 for
 Assault
 and
 battery.

That any person or persons who shall be guilty of any assault or assault and battery within the limits of the Town of Dundee shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder, shall be fined not less than five (\$5) dollars, nor more than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars or imprisonment, in the Town or County jail, not to exceed sixty (60) days.

"Sec 3rd"

Fines
 for
 selling
 Liquor to
 Minors
 or
 Intoxicated
 persons

Any keeper of a bar-room or drinking shop who shall permit any breach of the peace or disturbance of public order by noisy or disorderly conduct on the premises or who shall sell or give any intoxicating liquors to any to any person already intoxicated or to any person under the age of legal majority or who shall allow or permit any minor to remain in or about any bar-room-drinking shop under his control, shall be deemed

guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof be fined not less than twenty five (\$25) dollars, nor more than fifty (\$50) dollars or be imprisoned in the town or County jail not less than ten (10) days nor more than twenty five (25) days and shall forfeit the license to such bar-room or drinking shop.

"Sec 4"

In all cases of conviction for any of the offences mentioned in any town ordinance, the Recorder shall adjudge the offender to pay the cost of prosecution and shall in default of payment of fine and cost, commit the offender to the town or County jail for a term of imprisonment, not to exceed sixty (60) days and in all cases where the term of punishment in jail in lieu of a fine shall not be fixed by the Recorder. The offender shall be imprisoned in default of fine, one day for every two (2) dollars of such fine

"Sec 5"

Inasmuch as there is a great need of this ordinance in the Town of Dundee the same shall take effect, within five (5) days from date of approval
