

Ordinance No 11

An Ordinance authorizing the Oregon & California Railroad Company to lay, maintain and operate a side track on Blocks 6 and 26 in the townsite of Dundee, and on the county road and Tenth Street, in said townsite, and on tracts 74, 75 and 76, in Dundee Orchard Homes Number 1.

The people of the town of Dundee do ordain as follows:

That whereas Thomas Prince owns, maintains and operates, in the town of Dundee, an extensive plant for drying, curing and packing prunes and kindred products, which is of material benefit to said town and its people.

And whereas the council of said town of Dundee has permitted said Thomas Prince to construct, maintain and operate a side track, connecting said plant ~~with~~ with the railroad of the Oregon & California Railroad Company, which passes through said town of Dundee, at a point South Easterly from block 26 in the townsite of Dundee, as shown by the plat thereof recorded in Yamhill County, which said side track passes over blocks 6 and 26 in said townsite, and crosses the county road, upon which said blocks abut, as shown on said plat, and passes along and over Tenth Street, in said townsite, and tracts 74, 75 and 76, in Dundee Orchard Homes Number 1, as shown by the plat thereof, recorded in Yamhill County.

And whereas said side track has been constructed at the joint expense of said Thomas Prince and said Oregon & California Railroad Company, and is of great benefit to said plant and to the owner thereof, and to the town of Dundee and its people.

NO W THEREFORE the right and privilege is hereby granted to the Oregon & California Railroad Company, a corporation, duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Oregon, to maintain and operate said side track as now located and constructed, connecting said plant and

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said railroad, — the portion of said track which passes over said county road and said Tenth Street, to be kept and maintained flush with the established grade thereof.
