

ORDINANCE NO. 15.

An ordinance declaring when poll tax shall become due; When poll tax shall become delinquent; Providing a penalty for the non-payment of polltax before the same becomes delinquent; providing a method of collecting poll tax and repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF DUNDEE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

Sec. #1.

Poll tax in the Town of Dundee shall become due and payable on the 15 day of March each year.

Sec. #2.

If the poll tax as levied by the Town Council, under the provisions of the charter of the town of Dundee be not paid on or before the 15 day of November of each year then said poll tax shall become delinquent.

Sec. #3.

If Poll tax shall become delinquent as provided in sec. #2 of this ordinance the Town Marshal shall serve a written Notice upon each and every person whoes poll tax has so become delinquent requiring him to pay said poll tax within three days from the date of service of said written notice and further notifying him that unless said poll tax is paid within the three days from the service of said notice a penalty of \$/ \$1.00 will be attached thereto. From and after the expiration of the three days after the service of the said written notice if the poll tax still remains un paid the sum of \$1.00 shall be added thereto.

Sec. #4.

The Town Marshall shall collect the poll tax as levied by the Town Council. He shall keep a record of all who pay poll tax and upon the day after the date provided in sec#2 of this ordinance for unpaid poll taxes to be come delinquent, or as soon

thereafter as may be he shall serve upon all persons subject to
who have not paid said poll tax
the payment of poll tax, a written notice as provided in se. #3
of this Ordinance. He shall certify the making and serving said
notice to the Town Recorder. Upon the expiration of the three
days as required by this Ordinance after the serving of said
written notice the Town Recorder shall make a record of the
added penalty upon said certificates of service and shall report
the same to the Town Council.

Sec. #5.

If the said delinquent poll tax, with the added penalty is
not paid within 30 days from the time the Recorder reports the
certificates of service with the added penalty to the Town Council
it shall be the Duty of the Town Marshal to sue the delinquent
polltax payers in the Recorders Court, and after judgement is
rendered have execution issued and proceed to levy upon the person-
al property of the said delinquent polltax payers.

Sec. #6.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith
are hereby repealed.
