

ORDINANCE NO. 165

AN ORDINANCE PROPOSING A CHARTER AMENDMENT TO THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF DUNDEE, YAMHILL COUNTY, OREGON, BY AMENDING SAID CHARTER TO PROVIDE FOR THE ELECTION OF TWO ADDITIONAL COUNCILMEN, AND CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO VOTE UPON THE SAME, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF DUNDEE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it is unanimously found and declared by the council that due to the growth of the city of Dundee there is a need for two additional councilmen for the city, in order to carry out the business of the council and city, and that there is herewith proposed to be submitted to the voters of the city of Dundee, Oregon, the following charter amendment:

CHARTER AMENDMENT SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS BY
THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUNDEE, OREGON

AN ACT to amend the charter of the city of Dundee, Oregon, by providing for the election of two additional councilmen, making a total of six councilmen for the city of Dundee, Oregon.

THE CITY OF DUNDEE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Be it enacted by the legal voters of the City of Dundee, Yamhill County, Oregon, that section 9 of the charter of said city be amended to read as follows:

Section 1. COUNCIL. The council shall be composed of six councilmen elected at large. The term of office of each of the four councilmen in office when this charter is amended shall continue for the terms for which they were elected. Within six months after the date on which this charter is amended, a special election shall be held at which two additional councilmen shall be elected. One shall be designated to serve a term ending at the time of the first regular council meeting in January, 1976, and one shall be designated to serve a term ending at the time of the first ^{REGULAR} council meeting in January, 1978. At each biennial general election after this charter is amended, three councilmen shall be elected, each for a term of four years.

Section 2. That the said charter amendment shall be and is hereby filed with the city recorder for submission to the legal voters of said City of Dundee for their approval or rejection, to be voted upon at a special election to be held as herein provided.

Section 3. That a special election is hereby called within, for and by the City of Dundee, to be held on Tuesday, the 5th day of November, 1974, beginning at the hour of 8:00 o'clock in the forenoon and continuing until the hour of 8:00 o'clock in the afternoon of said day; that the voting place

for said election shall be the City Hall in Dundee, Oregon; that the following persons be and are hereby appointed as judges of said election:

KATE NIEDERBERGER

and the following named persons be and are hereby appointed as clerks of said election: Clara Robertson and Thelma Herring and

Kate Niederberger is hereby designated as chairman, and that said special election is hereby called for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the City of Dundee, Oregon, the charter amendment hereinabove set forth in this ordinance.

Section 4. That the City Recorder is hereby ordered to cause the ballot title for said charter amendment to be prepared as by law required, and to have the necessary notices posted and to prepare the ballots for said special election, all in the manner required by law.

Section 5. That the council desires and deems it necessary and advisable for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the City of Dundee that this ordinance take effect at once and therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
