ORDINANCE No. ~~9117~~

An ordinance prohibiting the climbing upon, boarding or entering of railroad cars, trains ~~or~~ engines, <sup>Automobiles, buggies and Wagons</sup> by Persons other than railroad employees, at any place within the corporate limits of the <sup>Town</sup> ~~City~~ of ~~Portland~~ <sup>Dundee</sup>, except passengers at depots, platforms and other regular stopping places of such cars, trains and engines.

WHEREAS, Boys and other unauthorized persons are in the habit of climbing upon, getting aboard of and entering platforms and other portions of railroad cars, trains and engines, <sup>and climbing on wagons Automobiles & Buggies</sup> within the corporate limits of the <sup>Town of Dundee</sup> ~~City of Portland~~, at points other than regular stopping places for passengers, to the endangering of life and limb and to the annoyance and hinderance of the railroad companies in the exercise of their duties, ~~of the employes in charge of such trains,~~ cars and engines, and thereby tending to provoke assaults and breaches of the peace, therefore,

THE ~~CITY OF PORTLAND~~ <sup>Town of Dundee</sup> DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

Section 1. It is defined and declared to be unlawful for any persons other than railroad employes to climb upon, enter or get on board of any portion of any railroad car, railroad train or engine, <sup>or climb on any Automobile. Wagon or buggy without consent of owner</sup> ~~at any place within the corporate limits of the~~ <sup>Town</sup> ~~City~~ of ~~Portland~~ <sup>Dundee</sup>, except that passengers shall be allowed to board passenger cars at regular stopping places of any such railroad companies for passengers.

Section 2. No person other than railroad employees in the actual service of such railroad company shall climb upon, enter or get on board of any portion of any railroad train, railroad car or <sup>or climb into any Automobile. Wagon or buggy without consent of owner</sup> locomotive engine at any place within the corporate limits of the <sup>Town</sup> ~~City~~ of ~~Portland~~ <sup>Dundee</sup>, except that passengers shall be allowed to board

passengers cars in the usual way prescribed by any such railroad companies at their regular stopping places for passengers.

Section 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the <sup>Town Recorder</sup> ~~municipal judge~~ of the <sup>Town</sup> ~~city~~ of <sup>Dundee</sup> ~~Portland~~ shall be punished by a fine of not less than five dollars or more than twenty five dollars, or in default of payment of such fine by imprisonment for not less than two nor more than ten days.
