

Ordinance No. 22 ^{17 B} ~~A~~

An ordinance granting to the Yamhill Electric Company, its successors and assigns the right, privilege and authority to erect poles and wires thereon for electric lights, power and heat, and to lay mains and pipes for gas light, in the ~~City~~ ^{Town} of Dundee, Yamhill County, Oregon.

The people of the ~~City~~ ^{Town} of Dundee do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That there be and there is hereby granted unto the Yamhill Electric Company of Newberg, Yamhill County, Oregon, its successors and assigns, for the period of twenty years from the date of the approval of this ordinance, the right, privilege and authority to erect poles and wires thereon upon and over all the streets and alleys at present existing in the said ~~City~~ ^{Town} of Dundee or that may hereafter be laid out, for the purpose of furnishing and supplying electric lights, power and heat, to lay and maintain mains and pipes on all of said streets and alleys for the purpose of gas lights and gas heat and manufactured gas, and to maintain and operate the same for said or any of said purposes.

Section 2. The said Yamhill Electric Company, its successors and assigns shall have the power and authority to erect and carry side wires, mains, or pipe to all buildings in said ~~City~~ ^{Town} of Dundee where they may contract light, power or heat.

Section 3. All poles shall be constructed and erected in a workman-like manner and when erected in or near a street having a sidewalk they shall be placed inside of and adjoining the curb.

Section 4. The said wires shall be insulated in the latest approved manner in general use and carefully connected and fastened, and shall be stretched so as not to interfere with the free and unobstructed use of said streets and alleys for travel and at good ordinary height for such purpose, and in case it should be necessary to cut any wire in order to get at any building during a fire, the privilege is hereby granted and the said Yamhill Electric Company, its successors or assigns, shall in no wise claim any damages therefor of the ~~City~~ ^{Town} of Dundee.

Section 5. That whenever it shall become necessary in the erection of said poles to take up any portion of the sidewalk or dig up the ground in or near the sides and corners of said streets or alleys, then the said Yam-

hill Electric Company, its successors or assigns shall after said poles are erected without delay replace said sidewalk and properly refit the joints of said sidewalk in a workmanlike manner, and shall put such sidewalk, street or alley in as good condition as it was before it was so taken up, dug up or disturbed.

Section 6. All gas mains or pipes laid under or by virtue of this ordinance shall be laid at an ordinary depth and in the ordinary manner for such purposes.

Section 7. It is hereby understood and agreed that the said Yamhill Electric Company may by assignment or transfer convey all or any part of the right, privileges, power and authority hereby granted to it.

Section 8. The said Yamhill Electric Company, its successors or assigns shall commence to furnish electric or gas light in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance within six months from the approval of this ordinance, and shall furnish a sufficient number of lights as may be necessary to supply the ^{Town} ~~City~~ of Dundee and the citizens thereof at a price and for a term to be agreed upon between the consumer and company furnishing said electric light or gas light, provided, the price charged for electric lights shall not exceed the sum of twenty cents per thousand watt hour.

Section 9. Provided that in event of failure by the said Yamhill Electric Company to furnish such lights within six months from the approval of this ordinance then this ordinance to be void and of no effect.

Section 10. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons at any time during the construction or operation of the facilities herein provided for to obstruct, injure, damage or interfere with the same or any part thereof, and any one convicted of such offense before the recorder of the ^{Town} ~~City~~ of Dundee, shall be fined in a sum not exceeding twenty-five dollars or be imprisoned for a term of not exceeding ten days for each and every offense so committed.

Section 11. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
