An Ordinance to vote a special tax of three mills per annum. To maintain the expense of the town, and to make such ~~necessary~~ improvements as the council may deem necessary.

The people of the town of Dundee do Ordain as follows:

That a special tax of three mills per annum shall be levied by the town council of Dundee to maintain the expense of the town and to make such ~~necessary~~ improvements as the council may deem necessary.
