

## Ordinance No. 20

An Ordinance to prevent the throwing of rubbish or refuse of any kind in any streets, alleys, or vacant lots within the Corporate limits of the town of Dundell.

The people of the town of Dundell do ordain as follows.

It shall be unlawfull for any person or persons to throw any rubbish or refuse of any kind in any streets, alleys, or vacant lots within the corporate limits of the town.

Any person or persons violating the provisions of the above ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof in the recorder's court shall be fined not less than one dollar (\$1.00) and not more than Ten dollars (\$10.00) and the necessary costs of prosecution.

This ordinance shall be in effect on and after April 15, 1911
