

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 184 OF THE CITY OF DUNDEE, OREGON, PROVIDING FOR COMPETITIVE BID EXEMPTIONS TO PUBLIC CONTRACT PROCEDURES FOR THE CITY, AND REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

THE CITY OF DUNDEE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:



Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 184, passed and approved by the Council and the Mayor of the City of Dundee on the 5th day of January, 1976, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3. Competitive Bids; Exemptions.

(1) All contracts shall be based upon competitive bids except:

- (a) Contracts made with other public agencies or the Federal Government.
- (b) Contracts for any purchase the amount of which is less than \$3,000.00 with approval of the City Council and compliance with the city charter, subject to Subsection (c).
- (c) Informal bids only shall be necessary for any purchase (contract) which exceeds \$500.00 but is less than \$3,000.00. Informal bids shall be considered to be the procedure whereby the department head of the city ascertains by correspondence, telephone calls or direct contact, the various prices for the item involved, quoted by the number of reliable firms that shall have said items for sale. The department head shall cause to be kept all records and evidence of such informal bids, and after obtaining the same, the purchase may be made by the department head after obtaining the approval of the City Council of the City of Dundee.
- (d) Contracts for any item which is available only through one company, firm or individual.
- (e) Contracts for price-regulated items.
- (f) Copyrighted materials.
- (g) Advertising contracts.
- (h) Investment contracts. The Council of the City of Dundee may without competitive bidding, contract for the purpose of investing public funds or the borrowing of funds by the City of Dundee when such investment or borrowing is legally contracted.
- (i) Insurance contracts.
- (j) Data processing contracts.
- (k) Contract amendments.

All the above exempt contracts shall be subject to the approval of the City Council and comply with the city charter.

(2) The Common Council of the City of Dundee, the Contract Review Board, finds that as to (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), (h),

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(i), (j) and (k) of ~~this~~ subsection, that these exceptions meet the criteria contained in ORS 279.015, namely, that the lack of bids will not result in favoritism or substantially diminish competition in awarding the contract and the exception will result in substantial cost savings. These findings were made after due deliberation by the City Council and said Board considered the type, cost, amount of the contract, number of persons available to bid and such other factors as the Board deemed appropriate.

Section 2. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, of the City of Dundee in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
