

Ordinance No. 21

An ordinance to vote a special tax of two mills per annum to be used for street and sidewalk improvement.

The people of the town of Dundee do ordain as follows, That a special tax of two mills per annum shall be levied by the town council of Dundee for street and sidewalk improvement.

The above ordinance will be submitted to the owners of taxable property in the town of Dundee for approval or rejection at an election which will be held at the Council room on Saturday the 9th day of December 1911. Poles to be open from 6 to 8 P.M.
