

ORDINANCE NO. 216

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CALLING OF A CITY TAX BASE ELECTION IN THE CITY OF DUNDEE, OREGON, ON MAY 20, 1980, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF DUNDEE, OREGON, THE QUESTION OF ESTABLISHING A NEW TAX BASE FOR THE PURPOSE OF APPLYING THE LIMITATION ON TAXATION SET FORTH IN SECTION 11, ARTICLE XI, OREGON CONSTITUTION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.



WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Dundee, Oregon, has determined that a new tax base should be established as authorized by Subsection (2), Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, in order to permit the proper operation of the city affairs within the limitation contained in Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to submit the question of establishing a new tax base to the legal voters of the City of Dundee, Oregon, now, therefore,

THE CITY OF DUNDEE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Date of Election. The proposition set forth in Section 2 of this Ordinance shall be submitted in the manner prescribed in this Ordinance to the legal voters of the City of Dundee, Oregon, at a city tax base election to be held on May 20, 1980.

Section 2. Form of Proposition. At the city tax base election, there shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Dundee, for their approval or rejection, the following proposition:

ESTABLISHING A NEW TAX BASE.

Shall Dundee, Oregon, establish a new tax base of \$ 80,000⁰⁰, effective in the 1980-81 fiscal year?

This proposition will establish a new tax base for the City of Dundee under the limitation on taxation in Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, for the purpose of paying for increased city operating

costs. The present tax base is \$ 32,880⁰⁰.
The new tax base will be \$ 80000, and will
first apply to fiscal year 1980-81. In future fiscal
years, a 6 percent increase is allowed without voter
approval.

Section 3. Notice of Election. Not earlier than 20 and not later than
10 days before the election, the City Recorder shall issue a notice of election
and cause it to be posted in three public places in the city, including the
City Hall. The notice shall be substantially the same as the ballot measure
in Section 2 of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Posting of Notices; Voters' Pamphlets Unnecessary. The City
Recorder shall post or cause to be posted the notices required by Section 3
of this Ordinance. The notices of the city tax base election required to be
given by Section 3 of this Ordinance shall constitute the only notice necessary,
and all ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith shall not apply to the
notices required to be given on this election. It shall be unnecessary for
either the City of Dundee or any official thereof to furnish the legal voters
at the city tax base election pamphlets containing either (a) the text of the
proposition, or (b) arguments in support of or in opposition to the proposition,
or to otherwise advertise or post the measure to be voted upon.

Section 5. Emergency Clause. The council desires and deems it necessary
and advisable for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety
of the City of Dundee that this ordinance take effect at once, and therefore
an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full
force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
