

ORDINANCE NO. 216A

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A TAX LEVY OF \$37,880.00 FOR THE CITY OF DUNDEE, OREGON, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1980-81, FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING CITY OPERATIONS, SUBJECT TO APPROVAL OF THE VOTERS, CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO VOTE UPON THE SAME AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF DUNDEE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it is unanimously found and declared by the council that the City of Dundee is in serious need of funds to maintain the present level of services in the city, considering increased costs of operation, salaries and fixed charges, that such services are needed at once, that adequate funds are not available therefor in the regular budget of the city, that it is necessary to obtain the funds for such purpose by a tax levy in the manner herein set forth.

Section 2. That, subject to a vote being had authorizing the same, there is hereby authorized and levied a tax levy in the total sum of \$37,880.00, in excess of the 6% constitutional limitation imposed by Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, to be apportioned and levied and placed upon the tax roll of Yamhill County, Oregon, against all taxable property within the City of Dundee, Oregon, for the fiscal year 1980-81, for the purpose of obtaining funds to finance the city's operations during said fiscal year.

Section 3. That a special election is hereby called within, for and by the City of Dundee to be held on Tuesday, the 24th day of June, 1980, beginning at the hour of 8:00 o'clock in the forenoon of said date and continuing until the hour of 8:00 o'clock in the afternoon of said day, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the City of Dundee, Oregon, the question of whether the above mentioned tax levy shall be approved.

Section 4. That the City Recorder is hereby ordered to give proper notice hereof to the Yamhill County Clerk and to have the necessary notices posted for

said special election all in the manner required by law.

Section 5. The council desires and deems it necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the City of Dundee, and the inhabitants thereof, that this ordinance take effect at once, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall go into effect immediately upon its adoption by the council and approval by the Mayor.
