AN ORDINANCE to vote a special tax of three Mills per annum to be used for the purpose of street and Sidewalk improvement.

THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF DUNDEE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS.

THAT a special tax of three mills per annum shall be levied by the Town Council of Dundee for the purpose of street and sidewalk improvement.

The above Ordinance will be submitted to the owners of taxable property in the town of Dundee for approval or rejection at an election which will be held at the Council room on the day of May 1913
