



AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION WITHIN THE CITY OF DUNDEE, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF DUNDEE, OREGON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That certain set of documents entitled "Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction in the City of Dundee, Oregon," consisting of four sections, prepared by the consulting engineer for the City of Dundee and reviewed by staff, is hereby adopted as the standard specifications for public works construction in the City of Dundee, Oregon. A copy of said specifications is available and on file in the office of the City Recorder and is by this reference made a part hereof. Work done and materials used for public works construction in the City of Dundee, Oregon, shall conform to these standards unless otherwise provided in the particular specifications for work authorized by the council.

Section 2. All previous ordinances in conflict herewith, or parts thereof, are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Any person who violates any of the provisions of said specifications or fails to comply therewith, or who builds in violation of any detail statement of the specifications or plans submitted and approved thereunder, or any certificate or permit issued thereunder, or who fails to comply with any such order as affirmed or modified by the city council or by a court of competent jurisdiction, is for each and every such violation and noncompliance respectively guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$300.00, or by imprisonment for not less than one day nor more than ninety days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. The imposition of one penalty for any violation shall not excuse the violation or permit

it to continue. All such persons shall be required to correct or remedy such violations or defects within a reasonable time. When not otherwise specified, each period of ten days that a prohibited condition is maintained shall constitute a separate offense. The application of any of said penalties shall not be held to prevent the enforced removal of the prohibited condition.

Section 4. The council desires and deems it necessary for the preservation of the health, peace and safety of the City of Dundee, that this ordinance take effect at once, and therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
