



ORDINANCE NO. 249

AN ORDINANCE LIMITING ADDITIONAL RURAL WATER HOOK-UPS TO THE CITY OF DUNDEE, OREGON.

WHEREAS, the City of Dundee has for some years been faced with the recurring problem of a water shortage, which has from time to time caused great inconvenience to the city and water users in the city, and to property users in the city desiring to develop their property, which problem continues to exist and will likely require the city to look for and finance additional water sources in the future, now, therefore,

THE CITY OF DUNDEE, OREGON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It is hereby declared to be the policy of the City of Dundee, Oregon, that no further water hook-ups are to be permitted to the city water system, or to the presently existing rural water lines being serviced by the city.

Section 2. This policy shall remain in force until changed by further ordinance of the City Council.
