

ORDINANCE NO 25.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ERECTION AND MAINTAINING OF TELEPHONE WIRES, AND THE NECESSARY SUPPORTS THEREFOR ON AND OVER THE STREETS OF THE TOWN OF DUNDEE: OREGON.

THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF DUNDEE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS

Section 1. The said Yamhill County Mutual Telephone Company their successors and assigns be and are hereby granted the right and privilege of erecting and maintaining, operating and using in and along and over any and all the streets of the Town of Dundee, Telephone wires.

Section 2. The Said Yamhill County Mutual Telephone Company, its successors and assigns shall have the right to and shall erect poles and stretch wires so as not to interfere with the free and unobstructive use of the streets, shall erect the poles at such points in the streets and place the wires at such height as may be designated by the town council of Dundee.

Section 3. Whenever it shall become necessary in the erection or repairs of such poles and wires to dig into or in any manner interfere with any public streets or part thereof, the said Yamhill County Mutual Telephone Company its successors or assigns, shall without delay put the streets in as good condition as they were before broken up, dug up or disturbed and shall remove all surplus earth, or other material.

Section 4 The said Yamhill County Mutual Telephone Company its successors or assigns shall commence the construction of said Telephone system within thirty (30) days of the passage of this ordinance; the whole system to be completed within six months from the date aforesaid.

Section 5 The said Yamhill County Mutual Telephone Company its successors or assigns shall keep and maintain the said telephone system in proper working order and operate the same. In the event of the said Yamhill County Mutual Telephone Company its successors or assigns ceasing to operate the said telephone system for a period of six months (6) the said franchise shall be null and void, otherwise the said franchise will remain in full force and effect for a period of ten (10) years, from the date of this ordinance.

Section 6. Be it further ordained that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect for a period of ten (10) years from the date of the approval of this ordinance as long as the requirements and conditions herein stated and expressed are fully and faithfully complied with by the said Yamhill County Mutual Telephone Company its successors or assigns, but in the event of the failure of the said Yamhill County Mutual Telephone Company its successors or assigns to fulfill any or all of the provisions herein specified then this ordinance to be null and void.

Section 7. That it shall be un-lawful for any person or person to maliciously interfere or meddle with or injure or remove any of the poles, wires, boxes, or apparatus belonging to or pertain to said telephone system.

Section 8 That nothing in this ordinance shall be considered construed as in any way abridging the rights of the Town of Dundee to control all the streets, bridges and public thoroughfares of any description within the corporate limits of the Town of Dundee and by reason of such control it shall have the right at any time and all times to exercise a general supervision over the construction of said telephone system and shall make or cause to be made at the expense of the said Yamhill County Mutual Telephone Company its successors and assigns any changes, alterations, or repairs, temporary or otherwise, in said construction wherever such change alterations or repairs shall in its judgement be for the best interest of the public; Provided further that nothing in this ordinance shall be construed or considered as an exclusive franchise

Section 9 Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in a sum not exceeding twenty five (\$25.00) Dollars or be imprisoned for a term not exceeding ten (10) days for each and every offense so committed.

Section 10 This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor of Dundee.
