

ORDINANCE NO. 259

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 162 OF THE CITY OF DUNDEE, OREGON, CHANGING THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE CITY PLANNING COMMISSION FOR THE CITY.

THE CITY OF DUNDEE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 162, passed and approved by the Council and the Mayor of the City of Dundee on March 4, 1974, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. Membership. The commission shall consist of seven members who are not officials or employees of the city. Commission members shall receive no compensation, but may be reimbursed for expenses duly authorized by the city council. No more than two of said members shall be engaged principally in the buying, selling or developing of real estate for profit as individuals, or be members of any partnership, or officers or employees of any corporation that is engaged principally in buying, selling or developing of real estate for profit. No more than two of said members shall be engaged in the same kind of occupation, business, trade or profession.

Section 2. The reduction in the number of members of the Planning Commission shall be effected by non-appointment of replacements for the next two positions which are or become vacant upon the Planning Commission either by expiration of term or otherwise.

THE CITY OF DUNDEE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 162, passed and approved by the Council and the Mayor of the City of Dundee on March 4, 1974, is hereby amended to read as follows:
