



ORDINANCE NO. 266A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 64 OF THE CITY OF DUNDEE, OREGON, REGULATING AND LICENSING CERTAIN AMUSEMENT DEVICES AND DISTRIBUTORS THEREOF, PROVIDING PENALTIES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF DUNDEE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 64, passed and approved by the Council and the Mayor of the City of Dundee on January 4, 1954, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3. Application for License. Any distributor desiring to sell, lease, distribute, place or locate for operation in the City of Dundee any amusement device, as herein defined, shall make written application for license to do so and file the same with the city recorder. The application shall state the specific establishment or business location at which each amusement device is to be placed.

Section 2. Section 4 of said Ordinance No. 64 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 4. License Fee for Distributors. Each distributor's license shall be issued for a period of one year, and the annual license (fee) for each distributor shall be the sum of \$125.00 for each establishment or business location at which one or more amusement devices are to be placed.

At the time the city recorder issues the distributor's license, as hereinabove provided, he shall issue to the licensee a sticker or label evidencing the issuance of such license, which the distributor shall securely affix to each amusement device which he sells, leases, distributes, places or locates for operation in the City of Dundee.

Section 3. Section 9 of said Ordinance No. 64 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 9. Penalty.
(a) Any person not a distributor who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance

shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00, or by imprisonment in the city jail for not more than 45 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

(b) Any distributor violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than \$500.00 and not more than \$1,000.00, or by imprisonment in the city jail for not more than 45 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

(c) Any amusement device which is found to be maintained, kept or operated upon premises in the City of Dundee in violation of this Ordinance shall be disconnected or otherwise made inoperable by the city and shall be taken into the possession of the city, and the city shall have a lien thereon to secure the amount of any license fees due the city, together with the amount of any fines levied pursuant hereto and the necessary expenses in collecting the same.

Section 4. Said Ordinance No. 64 is hereby amended to add the following thereto:

Section 10. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.


