

ORDINANCE NO. 267A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 53 OF THE CITY OF DUNDEE, OREGON, CONCERNING THE COLLECTION OF WATER RENTALS FOR THE CITY.

THE CITY OF DUNDEE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 11 of Ordinance No. 53, passed and approved by the Council of the City of Dundee on October 16, 1951, and approved by the Mayor on October 19, 1951, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 11. Collection of Water Rentals.

That all water rentals and charges shall be payable to the city recorder at the city hall in the City of Dundee on the first of each and every month. If any water consumer shall fail to pay his water rental on or before the 10th day of any month, it shall be deemed delinquent; and if the said delinquent rental is not paid on or before the 15th day of said month, the water shall be turned off from said premises, and shall remain off until such water rental has been paid in full, including a turnon charge as specified in Section 4 of this ordinance, and also including a charge of \$ 10<sup>00</sup> processing charge for each check that has been returned to the city due to insufficient funds after being accepted for payment upon the delinquent account. That in the event a water consumer shall give the city a check for payment of water rentals, which check is returned to the city for insufficient funds, the city recorder shall not remove said water consumer or the premises involved from the delinquent list until the payment of the delinquent rental, including any turnon charges and check processing charges, has been paid in full in cash. That nothing contained in Section 2 of this ordinance shall be construed to limit or restrict the right of the city of Dundee to turn off the water from any premises on account of unpaid water rentals, and to keep the same turned off until said delinquent rentals and other charges incurred have been paid in full.
