AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 184 OF THE CITY OF DUNDEE, OREGON, AND PROVIDING EXEMPTIONS FROM THE REQUIREMENT OF COMPETITIVE BIDS FOR CONTRACTS OF THE CITY.

THE CITY OF DUNDEE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:



Section 1. Section 4 of Ordinance 184, passed and approved by the Council and the Mayor of the City of Dundee on the 5th day of January, 1976, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 4. Further Exemptions.

(1) Emergency Contracts. A contract may also be exempted from competitive bidding if the board, by unanimous vote, determines that emergency conditions require prompt execution of the contract. A determination of such an emergency shall be entered into the record of the meeting at which the determination was made, and if an emergency is so declared, any contract awarded pursuant to such decision must be awarded within 60 days following the declaration of the emergency, unless the board grants an extention.

(2) Surplus Property. A contract for the sale of surplus property of the city may also be exempted from competitive bidding if the board, by majority vote, determines that the number, value and nature of the items to be sold make it probable that the cost of conducting a sale by competitive bid would be such that a liquidation sale would result in substantially greater net revenue to the city. A determination of such facts shall be entered into the record of the meeting at which the determination is made.
