

ORDINANCE NO. 298A

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION WITHIN THE CITY OF DUNDEE, OREGON, REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, INCLUDING 244A, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF DUNDEE, OREGON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Those certain specifications for public works construction in the City of Dundee, Oregon, contained in the "Public Works Construction Standards" manual, dated October, 1990, and approved by the City Council on the 1st day of April, 1991, are hereby adopted as the standard specifications for public works construction in the City of Dundee, Oregon. One copy of said specifications manual, marked "Official Copy," is available and on file in the office of the City Recorder and is, by this reference, made a part hereof.

Section 2. All work done and materials used for Public Works Construction in the City of Dundee, Oregon, shall conform to the standards unless otherwise provided in the particular specifications for work authorized by the Council.

Section 3. Any person who violates any of the provisions of said specifications or fails to comply therewith, or builds in violation of any detailed statement of the specifications or plans submitted and approved thereunder, or any certificate or permit issued thereunder, or who fails to comply with any such order as affirmed or modified by the City Council or by a court of competent jurisdiction, is for each and every violation and noncompliance respectively guilty of a misdemeanor, and punishable by a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$300.00, or by imprisonment for not less than one day nor more than ninety days, or for such fine and imprisonment. The imposition of one penalty for any violation shall not excuse the violation or permit it to continue. All persons shall be required to correct or remedy such violations or defects within a reasonable time after notice from the City of Dundee. When not otherwise specified, each period of ten days that a prohibited condition is maintained shall constitute a separate offense. The application of any of said penalties shall not be held to prevent the enforced removal of the prohibited condition.

Section 4. All previous ordinances in conflict herewith, or parts thereof, are hereby repealed.

Section 5. The Council desires and deems it necessary for the preservation of the health, peace, and safety of the City of Dundee, that this ordinance take effect at once, and, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this


ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

addendum #1

STREET LIGHTS. All subdivisions shall include underground electric service, light standards, wiring, and lamps for street lights according to the specifications and standards of the Superintendent of Public Works. The subdivider shall install such facilities and make the necessary arrangements with the serving electric utility for a city-owned and operated street lighting system to be served at the lowest applicable rate available to the city. Upon the city's acceptance of subdivision improvements, the street lighting system, exclusive of utility-owned service lines, shall be and become the property of the city.
