



AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND LICENSING  
CERTAIN MACHINES AND DISTRIBUTORS THEREOF;  
PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION  
THEREOF; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF DUNDEE DO ORDAIN AS  
FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the term "machines" as used in this ordinance shall mean and include any and all machines and/or devices and/or apparatus of whatever kind, nature or description, when wholly through, or as a result of skill on the part of the persons playing the same, prizes, premiums, checks or other tokens of value are offered or given by the owner or person maintaining and/or operating the same, either directly or automatically by such machine and/or device and/or apparatus.

Whenever the word "distributor" is used herein it shall mean any person, firm or corporation selling, leasing, distributing, placing or locating with local firms or establishments any games, machines, or devices herein described.

Section 2. That it shall be unlawful for any distributor or any person to maintain and/or operate within the Town of Dundee any machine as hereinbefore defined, where such machine may be played by the public, without first having paid the license fees and procured the licenses therefore as herein provided.

Section 3. That any distributor desiring to sell, lease, distribute, place or locate for operation in the Town of Dundee any pinball game, marble game, or other game,

device, or machine, the playing or operation of which involves an element of skill, shall make written application for license to do so and file the same written application with the City Recorder. Such application shall show the name, address and place of business of the applicant, a description of the machine or machines, device or game sufficient to identify the same, and the total number of such machines, devices or games desired to be covered by the application, and shall also set forth the addresses and locations of the places where the applicant desires to sell, lease, place or locate said machines, and shall also state such other information as the Recorder may require.

Section 4. Each distributor's license shall be issued for a period of one year and the annual license fee for each distributor shall be \$15<sup>00</sup>. In addition to said \$15<sup>00</sup> license fee, the distributor shall pay \$3<sup>00</sup> per month for each machine, device or game hereinbefore mentioned, sold, leased, distributed, placed or located as hereinbefore provided, which \$3<sup>00</sup> fee shall license the leasing, placing and locating of such machines for a period of one month, and must be renewed at the expiration thereof if the distributor desires to continue the same.

Section 5. At the time the Recorder issues the distributor's license as hereinbefore provided, he shall issue to the licensee a sticker or label for each of the machines, devices or games licensed, and such sticker or label shall be securely affixed to the machine, device or game, and such sticker or label shall set forth a sufficient description of the machine, device or game to identify the same.

Section 6. It shall be unlawful to maintain,

keep or operate on the premises any such machine or device in condition or position that the same may be operated, played or used unless license has first been had thereon, in accordance with this ordinance, and unless such machine or device has affixed thereto in conspicuous place a sticker or label as hereinbefore provided. It shall be a violation of this ordinance for the owner, licensee or person in charge of any place or premises in the Town of Dundee to permit the use or operation of any such machine or device in his place or upon his premises, unless such machine or device has been licensed hereunder and has upon it a sticker or label as herein provided.

Section 7. It shall be unlawful for any person to permit or allow any such machine or device then in his possession or under his immediate control to be played or operated by any minor under the age of 21 years, or person of unsound mind, and the proprietor of any place of business wherein any such machine or device is operated or displayed shall be conclusively presumed to be the one in possession and control thereof.

Section 8. That no license shall be issued for any machine as herein defined, which machine by reason of the playing or operation thereof, shall violate the provisions of the laws of the State of Oregon or of the ordinances of the Town of Dundee with reference to gambling and/or slot machines.

Section 9. That any persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine not to exceed \$100.00

or by imprisonment in the Town jail of not to exceed 45 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 10. That in as much as machines, devices and games mentioned and described in this ordinance are now being operated in the Town of Dundee, and the Town of Dundee has no ordinance or measure regulating the operation thereof, and such regulation is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the people of said Town, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
