

ORDINANCE NO. 385

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 240 BY EXTENDING THE TERM OF A FRANCHISE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF DUNDEE AND TCI CABLEVISION OF OREGON, INC.

THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF DUNDEE, OREGON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 240 Amended. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 240 is hereby amended to extend the term of the franchise agreement with TCI Cable Vision of Oregon.

Section 2. Context. Ordinance No. 240 grants a nonexclusive franchise agreement to TCI Cablevision of Oregon Inc. to provide cable television services within the city. This agreement is contained in Ordinance No. 240, adopted December 16, 1981. The term of this agreement was for 15 years, and the expiration date was December 16, 1996. A general agreement between the cities of Yamhill County was that a new franchise agreement would be negotiated with TCI and adopted by each city. Negotiations began in early 1996. TCI Cablevision of Oregon merged with AT&T Corporation on June 23, 1998. AT&T has given notice of intent to negotiate a new cable television franchise agreement with the City. The notice of intent is dated December 21, 2000.


Section 3. Term Extended. The term of the franchise agreement with TCI Cable Vision of Oregon maybe extended to December 31, 2001, on the condition that AT&T agrees to pay as the franchise fee to the City of Dundee the full portion approved by the Oregon Public Utility Commission.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days from its second and final reading, after adoption by the City Council, and approval by the mayor; or, it shall become effective upon its second reading at the same Council meeting as the first reading, after adoption by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
