

ORDINANCE NO. 42

AN ORDINANCE LIMITING THE LOAD WEIGHT OF TRUCKS AND OTHER MOTOR VEHICLES OVER AND UPON TENTH STREET IN THE TOWN OF DUNDEE.

THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF DUNDEE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. No person shall operate or drive any motor vehicle over or upon Tenth (10th) Street in the Town of Dundee, in Yamhill County, Oregon, the gross loaded weight of which exceeds five ton.

SECTION 2. It shall be the duty of the Recorder of the Town of Dundee to have a highway sign 24" by 24" placed at each end to said Tenth (10th) Street to warn the public as to the maximum load weight that may be transported over and upon said Tenth (10th) Street.


SECTION 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than \$ 15.00 nor more than \$ 25.00.
