

ORDINANCE NO. 43

AN ORDINANCE TO REQUIRE THE PAYMENT TO THE TOWN OF DUNDEE OF AN ANNUAL LICENSE FEE ON ALL COIN OPERATED AMUSEMENT MACHINES.

THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF DUNDEE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That all persons, firms or corporations who keep and maintain upon or within their premises for operation, any coin operated amusement machine, within the corporate limits of the Town of Dundee shall pay unto the Town of Dundee an annual license fee of \$50.00 for each of said coin operated amusement machines so kept and maintained.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than \$ 15.00 nor more than \$ 25.00.

SECTION 3. Should any such person, firm or corporation while licensed to operate any coin operated machine, be convicted by any Court of competent jurisdiction of violating the Constitution or Laws of either the State of Oregon or of the United States of America, their said license to operate said coin operated amusement machine shall become immediately null and void.

ORDINANCE NO. 43

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND LICENSING CERTAIN
COIN OPERATED AMUSEMENT DEVICES AND DISTRIBUTORS,
PROVIDING A PENALTY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF DUNDEE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The term amusement device as used in this ordinance shall mean and include any and all machines, devices and/or apparatus of whatever kind or description played or operated by the public whether or not the player shall receive any money, check, token or other representative of value as a result of the operation of such amusement device.

That the term 'distributor' as used in this ordinance shall mean any person, firm or corporation selling, leasing, placing, distributing or localing with any local dealer, firm, establishment or individual in the Town of Dundee any amusement device as herein defined.

SECTION 2. That it shall be unlawful for any distributor or any person to maintain and/or operated within the Town of Dundee any amusement device where such device may be played by the public without first having paid the license fees and procured license therefor as herein provided.

SECTION 3. That any distributor desiring to sell, lease distribute, place or locate for operation in the Town of Dundee any amusement device as herein defined shall make application to do so and shall file same with the city recorder. Such application shall show name, address and place of business of applicant and the total number of amusement devices desired to be covered by application and shall set forth the addresses and location where applicant desires to sell, lease, place or locate such device together with such other information as the recorder may require.

SECTION 4. Each distributor's license shall be issued for one calendar year and the annual fee shall be \$25.00 and in addition each and all distributors shall pay a fee

therewith of \$12.00 per annum for each and every device hereinabove described which fee shall license the leasing, placing and/or locating of such devices for a period of one year or any part of the calendar year remaining. The license must be renewed at the end of the year if the distributor desires to continue thereof.

SECTION 5. Any person, firm or corporation, not a distributor, who shall desire to operate, place or locate for operation in the Town of Dundee, but is the owner thereof of any amusement device shall pay an annual fee of \$25.00 and in addition shall pay a fee of \$12.00 per annum for each and every device heretofore described.

SECTION 6. It shall be unlawful to maintain, keep or operate on the premises any device that may be played or operated or used unless license has first been issued and placed thereon.

SECTION 7. The proprietor of any place of business where any such device is operated or displayed shall be conclusively presumed to be the one in possession and control thereof.

SECTION 8. Should any person, firm or corporation while licensed for any of the above described devices be convicted by any Court of competent jurisdiction of violating the Constitution or Laws of the State of Oregon or of the United States of America, then the said license to operate said device shall immediately become null and void.

SECTION 9. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than \$15.00 or more than \$25.00 for the first offense.
