

ORDINANCE NO. 50

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE HOLDING OF A SPECIAL ELECTION ON THE 23RD DAY OF JANUARY, 1950, TO SUBMIT TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF DUNDEE, YAMHILL COUNTY, OREGON, FOR THEIR ADOPTION OR REJECTION, A CHARTER AMENDMENT PROPOSED BY INITIATIVE PETITION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS an initiative petition has been filed with the Recorder of the City of Dundee containing a number of signatures of legal voters of the City of Dundee in excess of 15% of the number of votes cast for Mayor of said city at the last preceeding election, said signatures having been duly verified; and

WHEREAS no regular election will be held in the City of Dundee within 90 days from the date of this ordinance; now, therefore,

The People of the City of Dundee do ordain as follows:

Section 1: A special election shall be and it hereby is called to be held on Monday the 23rd day of January, 1950, between the hours of 8:00 o'clock A.M. and 8:00 O'clock P.M. on said date, at which election there shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Dundee, Yamhill County, Oregon, for their adoption or rejection, the following proposed Charter Amendment submitted to the voters by initiative petition:

CHARTER AMENDMENT

Submitted by Initiative Petition

AN ACT

To amend the Charter of the City of Dundee, Yamhill County, Oregon, as amended.

Be it enacted by the City of Dundee, Yamhill County, Oregon, that the Charter of the said City of Dundee, as amended, be amended by adding thereto Chapter XI to read as follows:

CHAPTER XI

Section 1: For the purpose of procuring funds in an amount sufficient to defray the cost of purchasing and acquiring a new source of water supply for the said City of Dundee together with a water-shed for the protection and preservation of such source, and for the acquisition of sites and real property where necessary or desirable for the purposes hereinabove set forth, and for all other purposes necessary or desirable in order to carry out the purposes hereinabove set forth, the Council of the City of Dundee is hereby authorized and empowered to issue and dispose of General Obligation Bonds of the said city in the sum of Fifteen thousand and no/100ths (\$15,000.00) Dollars.

Section 2: The purchaser of said bonds shall in no way be required to see to the proper application of the purchase money therefor.

Section 3: The debt limitations contained in the Charter of said city shall not apply to the bonds hereby authorized.

Section 4: The Council shall, each year, at the time of making the annual tax levy for city purposes, make a special additional levy of a sum sufficient to pay interest on outstanding bonds of this issue, and to retire the principal thereof at maturity.

Section 2: The City Hall in the City of Dundee is hereby designated as the polling place for the above described special election and the following named persons are hereby designated and appointed as and for the Judges and the Clerks of said election: Martha Parrett, Judge; Ida Scott, Judge; Lena Powell, Judge; and

Florence H. Hildebrandt, Clerk and Catherine Miller, Clerk.

Section 3: The following shall be the form of the Ballot Title of said proposed Charter Amendment:

CHARTER AMENDMENT

Submitted to the Voters by Initiative Petition

AN ACT

To amend the Charter of the City of Dundee by adding thereto Chapter XI authorizing the issuance of \$15,000.00 in General Obligation Bonds to defray the cost of acquiring a new source of water supply and water-shed for said city and for all other purposes necessary or desirable in connection with the foregoing and to provide for the levy of a special tax to pay principal and interest on said bonds.

Section 4: The Recorder of the City of Dundee is hereby directed to give notice of this special election by transmitting by mail or carrier to every voter in the City of Dundee whose address she may have, one copy of a printed pamphlet setting forth a true copy of the title and text of the said proposed Charter Amendment with the number and form in which the ballot title thereof will be printed on the official ballot and also by posting a printed notice thereof stating the purpose of such special election and containing the said proposed Charter Amendment and Ballot Title, and further stating the place and time of voting at said special election and the names of the Judges and Clerks of the

election. Such notice shall be posted in three public places in each precinct in the City of Dundee not less than 10 days prior to said date of special election.

Section 5: In order to better preserve the public health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of Dundee, Oregon, and make immediate provision for additional water supply if said Charter Amendment be approved by the voters, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
