

ORDINANCE No. 99

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING PROCEDURES FOR NOMINATION OF OFFICIALS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF DUNDEE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. NOMINATING PROCEDURES. The legal voters of the City of Dundee may make nominations for all elective offices within the city in any of the following ways:

(1) By any regularly called convention of delegates representing the several wards of the city.

(2) By any convention of voters met for such purpose in any ward of the city making ward nominations.

(3) By any convention of voters met in city convention and representing the several wards in the city.

(4) By certificates of nomination signed by at least ten legal voters in each ward in case of ward nominations, or by at least ten legal voters of the city in case of nominations at large.

(5) In ^{either} event, a certificate of nomination shall be made out and signed by at least ten voters of the city and filed with the city recorder on or before the tenth day preceding the day of any regular election, to entitle the names of candidates nominated to be placed upon the ballot.

Section 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. The Council desires and deems it necessary for the preservation of the health, peace and safety of the City of Dundee that this ordinance take effect at once, and therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
