

BEFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PITTSBURG

Chapter 2.80, Youth Commission )

ORDINANCE NO. 09-1320

The City Council of the City of Pittsburg DOES ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION 1. Findings.

A. Ordinance 04-1218 was adopted on March 15, 2004 and, in part, established the Youth Commission;

B. Prior to the adoption of Ordinance 04-1218 the Youth Commission was an ad-hoc body of the City;

C. There were six (6) of the seven (7) Youth Commission vacancies appointed by the City Council effective September 1, 2004 with an original expiration date of June 30, 2006, later extended to a term expiration date of June 30, 2007;

D. The last known time the Youth Commission met was in September 2004;

E. There are presently no members appointed to the Youth Commission and the Youth Commission has not met in five (5) years;

F. Adoption of this ordinance is in the best interests of the citizens of Pittsburg.

SECTION 2. Repeal of Municipal Code Chapter 2.80

Pittsburg Municipal Code Chapter 2.80, "Youth Commission", of Title 2, "Administration and Personnel" is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 3. Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.


SECTION 4. Publication

The City Clerk shall either (a) have this ordinance published within fifteen (15) days after adoption in a newspaper of general circulation, or (b) have a summary of the

ordinance published twice in a newspaper of general circulation, once five (5) days before its adoption and again twenty (20) days after its adoption.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced at a meeting of the City Council of the City of Pittsburg held on October 19, 2009 and ordered published at a meeting of the City Council held on November 2, 2009 by the following vote:
